Capstone Quest - Contest Official Rules

Eligibility

1. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, Capstone “Capstone Quest Scavenger Hunt” Contest is open only to Canadian residents who are over the age of majority in their province/territory of residence at the time of entry. The City of Red Deer Managers, Directors, Councilors and Land & Economic Development staff (“Sponsor”) are not eligible to enter the Capstone Frame contest. Void where prohibited by law.

HOW TO ENTER

1. These official rules ("Contest Rules") apply to the “Capstone Quest Scavenger Hunt” contest (referred to herein as the “Contest”).
2. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, Capstone, sponsors the Contest.
3. To enter the Contest, Individuals must complete the long or short scavenger hunt route available on the RaidX app between July 19, 2021, and 11:59:59 PM MT on July 31, 2021. **Draws will take place within 24 hours of the promotion closing.** The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, Capstone, reserves the right to extend the contest due to inclement weather, to allow for safe participation in the contest.
4. One Entry per route completed - individuals may enter the Contest more than once.
5. The City of Red Deer is not responsible for lost, misdirected or delayed entries. The City will reject entries received via facsimile, telephone, courier, email, or other method not expressly permitted herein.
6. No purchase is necessary to enter the contest.
7. Must be 18 or older to receive prizes for the Capstone Quest Scavenger Hunt contest.

PRIZES AND WINNER SELECTION

8. There are ten (10) prizes of \$50 Gift Cards to retailers in Downtown (Capstone and Historic Downtown) for individuals who complete the “Long Route” in Capstone and Historic Downtown).
9. There are ten (10) prizes of \$25 Gift Cards to retailers in Downtown (Capstone and Historic Downtown) for individuals who complete the “Short Route” in Capstone.

10. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, Capstone, reserves the right to hold an Early Bird Draw on Saturday July 24, in which case two Early Bird prizes will be awarded. One (1) \$50 Gift Card prize for completion of the Long Route, and one (1) \$25 Gift Card prize for completion of the Short Route.

11. Prizes must be accepted as awarded. The Prizes may not be sold or transferred, and are not convertible to cash. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, Capstone reserves the right to substitute the Prize in whole or in part in the event that the Prize is unavailable. Prizes must be picked up in Red Deer

12. A random draw for the Prize will take place at City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development offices at The City of Red Deer, #1, 5000 51 St, Red Deer, AB from among all Eligible Entries received during the Contest Period.

13. The odds of winning the Prize will depend upon the total number of Eligible Entries received. The City of Red Deer, acting reasonably, will attempt to contact the potential winner by phone or email within two (2) business days after the draw. In the event a potential winner cannot be contacted within two (2) business days after the draw, he or she will be disqualified and an alternate potential winner will be drawn. Proof of identification must be provided upon request. In order to be declared a winner, a potential winner must first correctly answer, unaided, a time limited mathematical skill testing question administered by The City of Red Deer.

RELEASE AND INDEMNITY

14. Before being awarded a Prize, each potential winner may be required to execute and return, within the time stipulated by the City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, a release, indemnity and consent form stating that the potential winner has read and understood these Contest Rules, is eligible to receive the Prize under these Contest Rules, accepts the Prize as offered, consents to the public disclosure of the name and municipality of residence in conjunction with the identification of Contest Prize winners, and releases and indemnifies the City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development from any and all liability arising out of the potential winner's participation in this Contest and receipt and use of the Prize.

COMPLIANCE WITH CONTEST RULES

15. In the event that a potential winner does not comply with all the provisions as contemplated in these Contest Rules, The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, may disqualify the potential winner and may draw an alternate potential winner, and The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, shall be fully and completely released and discharged from any liability or responsibility in this regard. The provisions and procedures referred to above relating to the selection and notification of a potential winner, if applicable, shall be applied, with all necessary amendments, until a qualified winner has been duly selected.

16. By entering this Contest, all entrants and participants agree to accept and abide by these Contest Rules. All decisions of The City of Red Deer with respect to any aspect of this Contest, including without limitation the eligibility of entries, are final and binding on all entrants in all matters as they relate to this Contest.

LIABILITY

17. All entries become property of The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, which assumes no responsibility for garbled, lost, late, or delayed entries, or any computer errors or malfunctions. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, will not communicate with entrants or potential entrants, except to provide Contest Rules by mail or names of Prize winners (for which a self-addressed, postage paid envelope must be included).

18. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, does not assume any responsibility for incorrect or inaccurate capture of entry information, technical malfunctions, human or technical error, seeding or printing errors, lost, delayed or garbled data or transmissions, omission, interruption, deletion, defect or failures of any telephone or computer line or network, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof. Entry materials-data that have been tampered with or altered are void. If, for any reason, in the opinion of The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, in its sole discretion, this Contest is not capable of running as originally planned, or if the administration, security, fairness, integrity or the proper conduct of this Contest is corrupted or adversely affected, including by reason of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond its control, The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify, amend, extend or suspend this Contest including canceling any method of entry, and select a winner from previously received Eligible Entries.

RIGHT TO MODIFY OR CANCEL CONTEST

19. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, reserves the right to modify these Contest Rules without materially affecting the terms and conditions hereof. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of this Contest or to be acting in violation of these Contest Rules or otherwise in a disruptive manner. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, reserves the right in its sole discretion to right to terminate the on-line portion, as applicable, of this Contest and conduct the drawing from all on-line entries and all other entries (as applicable) previously received during the Contest Period. Any attempts to deliberately damage the Contest web site or to undermine the legitimate operation of this Contest may be a violation of criminal and civil laws, and, should such an attempt be made, The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, reserves the right in its sole discretion to seek remedies and damages to the fullest extent of the law. The City of Red Deer, Land and Economic Development, shall not be held responsible for any errors or negligence that may arise or occur in connection with this Contest including any damage to an entrant's computer equipment, system, software or any combination thereof, as a result of their participation in this Contest or from downloading any material from the Contest web site, where applicable.
